

Literacy Data Analysis: The 5Ds Process

The Marzano Research 5Ds data analysis process is an effective and easy way for district, school, or grade-level literacy teams, as well as multi-tiered system of supports (MTSS) teams, to use data to make important decisions about literacy programming. These decisions can include monitoring student progress, evaluating literacy program outcomes, and adjusting instruction and assessment practices.
